Water Utility Maintenance Technician

A. General Job Description: Performs general installation, repair, maintenance, and upkeep of facilities, equipment, and grounds. Under supervision of a licensed operator, operates and controls equipment designed to distribute potable water. Uses test equipment and color analysis standards. Monitors operating conditions, meters, and gauges and records readings on specified forms. Working knowledge of water distribution system methods, materials, practices, tools, machinery, technical equipment, occupational hazards, safety practices, and all applicable federal and state regulations. Corrects abnormal conditions.
